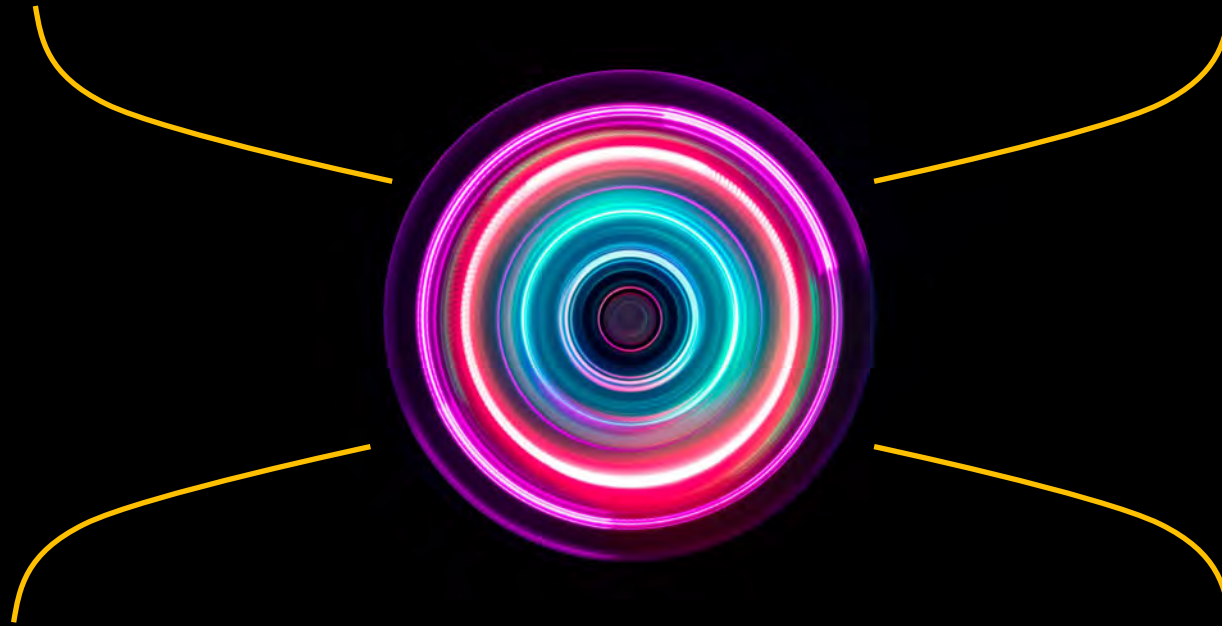

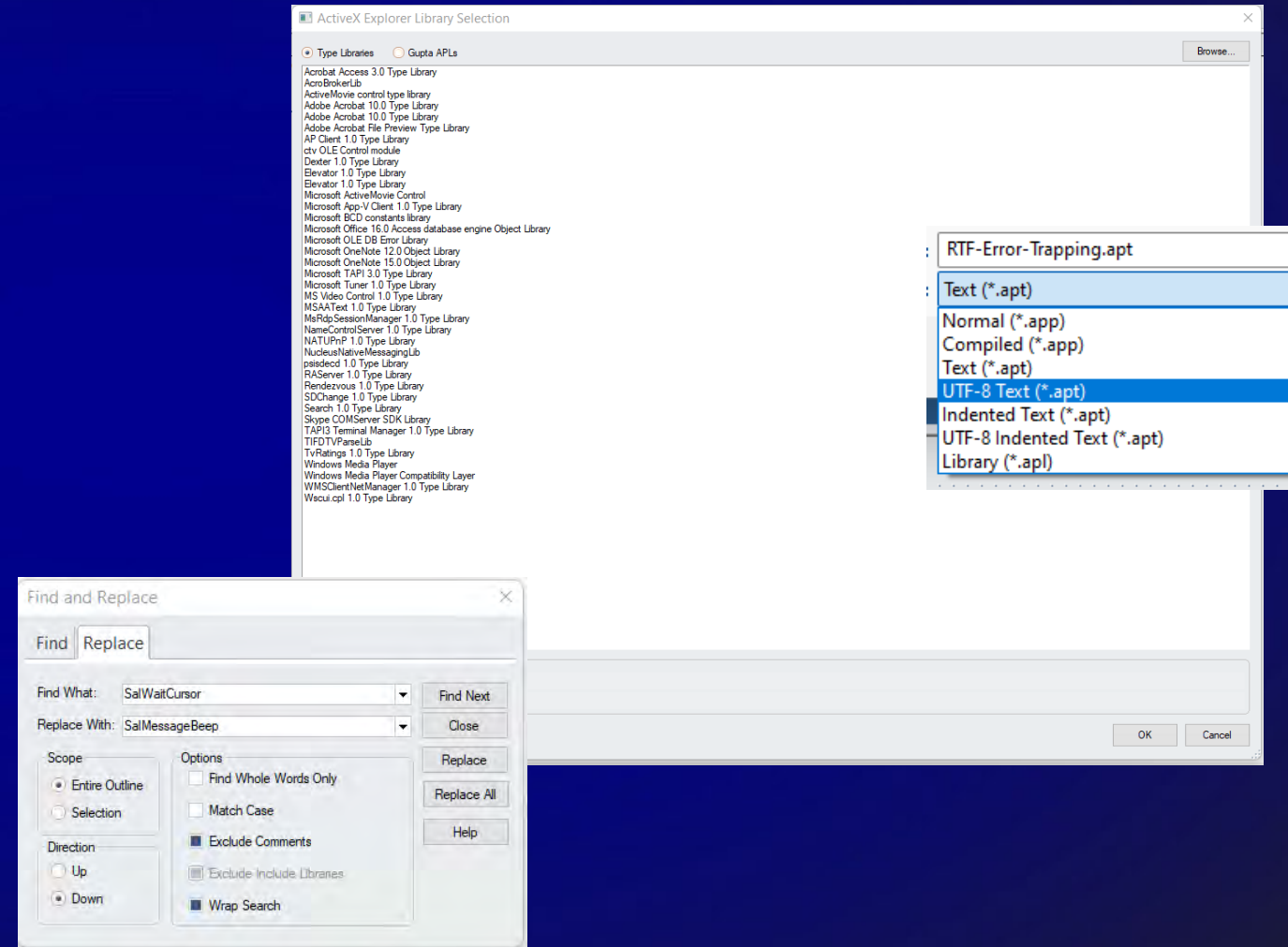
Team Developer 7.5 – IDE enhancements



- **Enhanced developer experience**
- **Enhanced file format support**
- **Easier to read generated code**

Enhanced developer experience

- IDE remembers position and size of ActiveX Explorer and Find dialog
- Save As UTF-8 at file level
- DotNetExplorer generates easier to read library code
- Leveraging the function overloading feature allowing the same function name having different signatures



Team Developer 7.5 – UX enhancements



- **Usability enhancements for Team Developer applications**
- **Grid and Ribbon enhancements**

Usability enhancements for applications

- Grid datetime column accepts inputmask
 - Define and assign your precise local input mask
- Ribbon separators now have a name for referencing them
 - For more developer control, be able to delete a Ribbon separator at runtime
- More choices for keyboard accelerators
- Hide close button of dockable dialogs
 - Prevent users from closing a dockable dialog
- Grid cell edits can be saved using <ESC> key
- Active Coding Assistant enhancement

Team Developer 7.5 – New APIs



- **API enhancements in several areas**
 - **Error trapping**
 - **CDK enhancements**
 - **Data export/import enhancements**
 - **Security enhancements**

New APIs

- Trappable `SalRTFDocumentSave()` errors
- `cdkBuildSettings` enhanced for .NET build targets
- International versions of `SalGridDataExport`
- Web Service operation can be added via CDK
- New API to detect current directory and executable file name
- Protection from in memory debugging of usernames and passwords

Team Developer 7.5 – Cool build features



- **Many new build options for**
 - **Increased runtime security**
 - **Improved build configuration**
 - **Virtualization support**

New build options

- Build option to add custom exe manifest files
- New Terminal Server Aware setting for use with application virtualization
- TD executables now use Address space layout randomization, Dynamic Base
