#### 2.1 New features

Gupta Team Developer 7.5.4 includes the following new features.

#### 2.1.1 IDE features

- Enabled to use environment variable for the path defined in Tools Preferences dialog. Following path settings support it.
  - SQL INI File Name
  - Skin Theme XML
  - Template
  - o Active X Libraries
  - o Global Path
  - Application Path
  - Application Image Path
- Add command line option, -q and -Q, to suppress showing the build progress dialog and error message box

#### 2.1.2 Sal API

- Modified SalTblDestoryColumns to destroy dynamically created columns even though table/grid contains static columns.
- Modified SqlGetParameter to get the path of sql.ini file even though provided Sql Handle is not valid. Following code always returns the full path of sql.ini file currently used.

#### Call SqlGetParameter( hSql, DBP\_SQLCONFIGFILENAME, nDummy, sPath )

- Added SAL function, SalRibbonSetFont, to specify font used for all text on Ribbon Bar.
- Added SAL functions, SalCalGetVisibleMonth and SalCalSetVisibleMonth, to get / set current visible month for date picker control.
- Added SAL functions, SalStrExpandEnvironment and SalStrExpandEnvironmentX, to expand environment variable used in given string.
- Added SAL functions, SalTblSetRowBackColor and SalTblQueryRowBackColor, to set/get background color of the current row in a table or grid.
- Added SAL function, SalWebGetQueryParam, to get the value of specified URL parameter. This
  can be used only for .NET WS operation.

#### 2.1.3 Native Router

 Modified ODBC and ORACLE native router to support SQL WITH clause (Common Table Expression).

#### 2.1.4 Web Service

Modified Web Service operation has no argument accepts only HTTP GET verb if it run as
RESTful service. But customer still need to modify web.config to accept only HTTP GET verb.
This no argument operation can get URL Parameter value by using SalWebGetQueryParam, and
return result based on this value.
 HTTP request should specify 'Content-Type' and 'Accept' headers to 'application/ison' to invoke.

HTTP request should specify 'Content-Type' and 'Accept' headers to 'application/json' to invoke such RESTful service with HTTP GET and get JSON data.

#### 2.1.5 Web Service Wizard for .NET

 o Modified Web Service Wizard for .NET to generate axl and apl files like as DotNetExplorer does. Win32 application can include this apl file to call Web Service in it via DotNetExplorer.

#### 2.1.6 Minidump

- Added bEnableMiniDump system variable to enable mini dump functionality from SAL code. This should be set On SAM\_AppStartup event section.
- Enabling to specify the folder where mini dump file will be generated. For the command line
  option, the folder can be specified after --minidump option. Or by setting TD\_DUMP\_LOCATION
  environment variable, and \_MiniDumpLocation system variable On AppStartup.
