2 About Gupta Team Developer

This section provides an overview of Gupta Team Developer 7.5.5.

This is Service Pack 5 for Gupta Team Developer 7.5

2.1 New features

Gupta Team Developer 7.5.5 includes the following new features.

2.1.1 IDE features

- The Window title of IDE was modified to show application name before product name such as "Sample - OpenText Team Developer (Win32) 7.5".

2.1.2 Sal API

- Added SAL function, SalAnchorSet, to set horizontal and vertical anchor property for the specified window.
- Make OF_UTF8 flag does not write UTF8 BOM when creating file. Use the new flag OF_UTF8_BOM to create a file having UTF8 BOM.
- Added SAL function, SalRTFDocumentCopy, to copy selected or all text in the specified Rich Text control to clipboard.
- The behavior of SalSetWindowSize for top level form is modified to match with the height set at design time. Previously the height set by SalSetWindowSize is shorter than expected just for the height of caption bar.
- Modified SalReportView to support RPT_EnableCache and RPT_DisableCache report option to enable / disable preview page cache functionality. You can specify it for nFlags of SalReportView.
- Added SAL function, SalReportSetMaxCache, to set the number of max pages in preview page cache to reduce memory usage. By default, all pages to be cached.

- Set bOldSalNumberRound system variable to TRUE to make SalNumberRound behave in backward compatible mode. By default, SalNumberRound(-0.5) returns -1. 7.3.4 and previous releases return 0.

2.1.3 Report Builder

- Print command on Report Preview shows Print Dialog with new L&F on Windows 11. But its setting does not follow paper type and orientation settings defined in QRP. To work around this issue print command was modified to force showing old Print Dialog on both Windows 10 and 11.

2.1.4 Table Control

- Enabled auto completion for drop down combo column on a Child Table or Table Window.

2.1.5 CDK

- cdkApplication.SetQuietMode function is added to suppress showing progress dialog.

2.1.6 Web Service Wizard for .NET

- Modified Web Service Wizard for .NET to choose generating library style, AXL or APL. Generating APL is like running the .NET Explorer after generating DLL. Also, generated APL defines instance variables for classes used for WS operations.

2.1.7 .NET Explorer

- Modified .NET Explorer to support following command options. All public classes in specific assembly will be imported.

Usage: Gupta.TD.DotNetExplorer.Wizard [-g <GAC Assembly> | -c <Custom Assembly>] [-o <Output Folder>] [-apl | -axl] [-? | -h]

Options:

- g Specify GAC assembly
- c Specify custom assembly
- o Specify output folder
- apl Generate application library (APL)
- axl Generate symbol import file (AXL)
